Working Professional Saturday MBA program Concentration requirements for 2020-21 second year students

Second year Saturday MBA students have the option of declaring and earning a degree concentration in either Business Analytics, Finance, or Leadership & Strategy during the 2020-21 year. A degree concentration is not a requirement of the MBA degree. Students who do not choose to pursue a concentration must complete 15.0 total hours of elective courses from any area to complete degree requirements.

Saturday MBA students who wish to earn a concentration in Business Analytics, Finance, or Leadership & Strategy must complete 9.0 approved credit hours of electives in the respective area beyond the standard MBA core.
